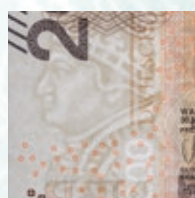


Modernised PLN 200 banknote in circulation since 12 February 2016



The watermark field is free from print. When viewed against the light, the multitone watermark is visible as a repeat of the sovereign's portrait on the front and the light monotone value numeral "200" (filigree).



The parts of the security thread are visible on the surface on the front side, the whole thread is visible when you look at the banknote against the light. When the banknote is tilted in vertical and horizontal directions, the additional effects become visible:

- the colour smoothly changes from gold to green;
- the chessboard pattern moves in vertical and horizontal directions.

In addition, there is microlettering on the security thread with the value numeral "200" and "200 ZŁ".



When the banknote is tilted, the shield to the right of the portrait changes colour from gold to green, and the chequered pattern appears to move in vertical and horizontal directions. Additionally, the stylized letter "S" with no print on it is visible.



The elements of the graphic design printed on each side align perfectly to form a complete image – a crown in an oval.
